SUBJECT: Austin Farmer's Market Fee Waivers

This item on the March 25, 2004 Council Agenda would fall under the following requirements of the City Code:

- * Section 15-11-21(B) -- Issuance of Permit (Applicable Fees).
- * Ordinance 030908-4 -- Fee Requirements

Under these provisions, the following fee would be applicable to the Jewish Community Day School's Bagelfest Fun Run/Walk held on March 14, 2004 :

\$ 1,500	<u>Permit Fee</u>
\$ 1,500	Total street closure fees reimbursed

In summary, the total cost impact of the fee reimbursement is \$1,500.

Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduce potential revenues that could be realized.
