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SUBJECT: Authorize negotiation and execution of a professional services agreement with the following six (6) firms: LAURIE SMITH DESIGN ASSOCIATES, (WBE/FR), Austin, TX; THE BOMMARITO GROUP, INC. (WBE/FR); LAUCKGROUP-I, INC., (WBE/FR) Austin, TX; TEAMHAAS ARCHITECTS, (WBE/FR) Austin, TX; PARSHALL + ASSOCIATES ARCHITECTS (WBE/FR), Austin, TX; and ARCHITECTURE + PLUS (WBE/FR) for professional architectural and/or interior design services to provide space planning for miscellaneous projects, for a period of approximately two (2) years or until financial authorization is expended, in an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000, or with a total aggregate amount of the six (6) agreements not to exceed \$1,200,000.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$1,200,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Capital Budged and/or Operating Budget of the Public Works Department and various other departments for which the services are needed.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

MBE / WBE: Participation subgoals stated in the solicitation were 8.7%MBE and 18.2% WBE.

Space planning involves planning, design, production, furniture selection and specification, bidding, construction administration and furniture installation coordination and review of installation for interior renovations and remodeling projects. In January 1999, City Council approved the selection of six (6) consultant firms to provide professional architectural and/or interior design services for the space planning rotation list for miscellaneous projects. This recommended action will replace the existing rotation list that has exhausted its authorization and provide for continuing space planning requirements of the Public Works Department and other departments as required.

The City anticipates contracting with six (6) firms for a period of approximately two (2) years or until contracting authority is exhausted. These six (6) firms will be compensated under a standing contract for \$250,000 for the three (3) highest ranking firms and \$150,000 for the next three (3) highest ranking firms. Initial project assignments will be based on the order of contracts executed. The City may, however, select a firm that is felt to be the most qualified for a specific project or most able to meet a project's schedule objectives. Project-specific schedules will be agreed upon at the time professional services are defined.

The total contracting authority for this rotation list is \$1,200,000. Compensation for individual project assignments will vary depending upon the scope of services required. Funding will come from the individual projects for which the services are provided.

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This request allows for the development of a professional service agreement with each of the recommended firms. Should the City be unsuccessful in negotiating a satisfactory agreement with a recommended firm, negotiations will cease with that firm and the funding will be distributed as equitably as possible among the remaining recommended firms.

Participation subgoals stated in the solicitation were 1.1% African-American, 5.9% Hispanic, 1.7% Native/Asian-American, and 18.2% WBE. The recommended firms provided M/WBE Compliance Plans, which were approved by the Department of Small and Minority Business Resources.

Notification of issuance of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the subject services was sent to one hundred seventy-three (173) firms on November 25, 2003. The RFQ was obtained by thirty-nine (39) firms, and twelve (12) firms submitted qualification statements. Nine (9) of the firms were certified M/WBE firms. Evaluation of the submittals of the twelve (12) firms results in the following recommendations:
