**SUBJECT:** Set a public hearing on the draft of the following documents: (1) the Five-Year Consolidated Plan for 2005-2009, which is the document submitted by the City of Austin to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development that serves as the planning document of the City and an application for federal funding; (2) the 2004-2005 Action Plan, which is a description of the activities the City will undertake during the year to address priority community-development needs; and (3) the 2004-2005 Community Development Program, which addresses the City's efforts to improve the living and economic conditions of persons of low- and moderate-income, benefit low- and moderate-income neighborhoods, aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blighted areas, aid federally assisted new communities, and meet other community needs. This public hearing is required by HUD and by Chapter 373 of the Texas Local Government Code, and is in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan, that sets forth the City's policies and procedures for citizen participation in the Consolidated Plan and Community Development Program.
