SUBJECT: Authorize execution of 12-month service agreement with TEXAS INFRARED, Beaumont, TX for infrared imaging inspections in an amount not to exceed \$53,400, with four 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$53,400 per extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$267,000.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$22,250 is available in Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Amended Operating Budget of the Electric Utility Department. Funding for the remaining seven months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

<u>PURCHASING</u>: Low bidder of three bids received.

MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program. No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide Austin Energy with Infrared/Ultraviolet Imaging Inspection Services. This state of the art technology will provide the means for Austin Energy to proactively reduce maintenance costs, minimize unscheduled outages and help establish a predictive maintenance plan. This technology assures power system reliability by detecting defective electrical components, equipment, and hardware in the early states of degradation. These services will be utilized for Austin Energy's transmission and distribution systems and substation facilities. The work will be performed at each location at various times as the need is determined by Austin Energy staff throughout the duration of this agreement.

- c. A price comparison with a spot purchase on October 2003 indicates these contract prices have decreased approximately 30%, which can be attributed to the price break for a much larger quantity.
