SUBJECT: Approve an ordinance amending Section 12-4-42 of the City Code by extending the 40 miles per hour speed limit on Becket Road, from Davis Lane to Slaughter Lane (West), and extending the 40 miles per hour speed limit on Riverside Drive (East), from Pleasant Valley Road (South) to Parker Lane.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$300 for the installation of the appropriate speed limit signs is available in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Operating Budget of the Transportation, Planning & Sustainability Department.



In order to modify or alter the existing prima facie speed limit of a street, the Texas Traffic Laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. The Transportation Division of the Transportation, Planning & Sustainability Department conducted an investigation in accordance with the procedures specified in the Texas Procedures for Establishing Speed Zones, 1997. As a result of this investigation, the Transportation, Planning & Sustainability recommends the following:

Amendment to Code Section 12-4-42 (40 MPH Speed Limit)

- 1. Extend along Beckett Road from Davis Lane to Slaughter Lane (West)
- 2. Extend along Riverside Drive (East) from Pleasant Valley Road (South) to Parker Lane.



ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-42 OF THE CITY CODE TO EXTEND THE BECKETT ROAD 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT AND TO EXTEND THE RIVERSIDE DRIVE (EAST) 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-42 (*Maximum Speed Limit of 40 Miles Per Hour*) of the City Code is amended as follows:

Beckett Road from Kiva Drive to Slaughter Lane (West) [Davis Lane]; and

Riverside Drive (East) from Pleasant Valley Road (South) to <u>Parker Lane</u> [Montopolis Drive].

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on ______, 2004.
