PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION: The selection of the consultant was approved on August 22, 2002.

PURCHASING: Lowest bid of four responsive bids received.

MBE / WBE: 21.88% DBE subcontractor participation.

The purpose of this project is to improve the security gates of the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport (ABIA). The ABIA Security Gates Improvements project will provide for the installation of new gate assemblies, gate operators, and associated equipment at various locations around the ABIA campus to improve the security gate system of the Airport. The project will be constructed under active airport and airfield conditions. This project is supported by FAA grant funding up to 75% of eligible project costs.

The contract allows one hundred twenty calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to ten general contractors and suppliers. Bids were opened on April 29, 2004. Auto Gate submitted the lowest of four responsive bids received:

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for three areas of subcontracting opportunities: fencing, gate operator equipment, and electronic equipment.

The DBE participation goal stated in the solicitation was 22%. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$240,180.04:

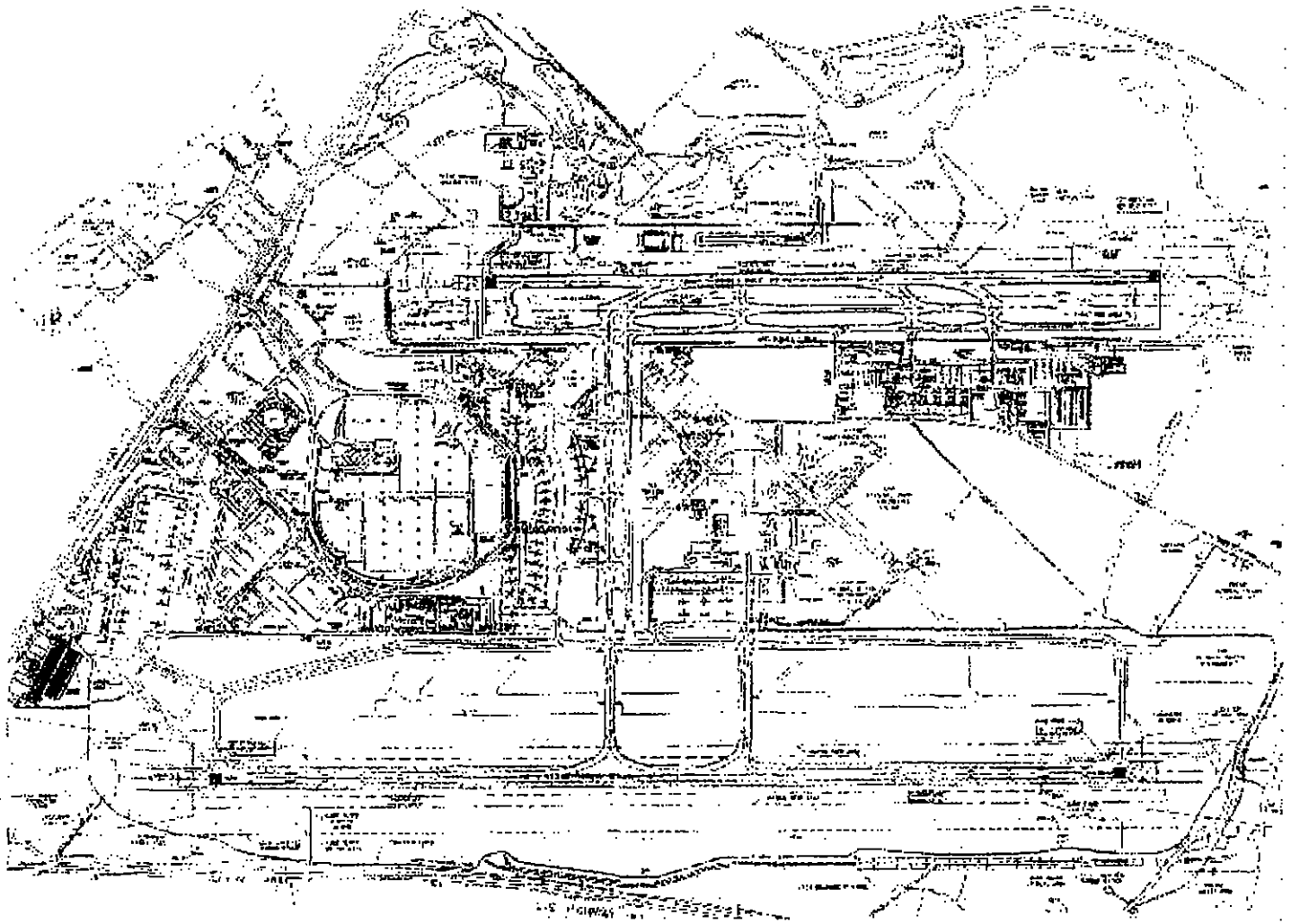

THRID BIDDER – Construction Rent-A-Fence, Thrall, TX - \$283,951.00 – Not reviewed
76.43% Non DBE prime participation; 23.57% DBE; 0% Non DBE subcontractor participation.
