<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of a construction contract with CASH CONSTRUCTION COMPANY LTD, Pflugerville, TX, for the Austin Clean Water Program - Windsor Water and Wastewater Improvements, Phase II, in the amount of \$1,052,532 plus a \$105,253.20 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,158,885.20.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$1,158,885.20 is included in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility Department.

This construction contract will provide for water and wastewater improvements within a residential area generally bounded on the east by Parkway, on the west by Woodlawn Blvd., on the north by 24th Street and on the south by Watch Hill Road, and for a new wastewater line in 24th Street. The improvements are intended to replace aging, deteriorated water and wastewater facilities, and to eliminate the wastewater overflows that have occurred in the area. The wastewater portion of this project is part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP), which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows.

The proposed improvements include construction of approximately 750 linear feet of new 8-inch wastewater line within 24th Street with related appurtenances and reconnecting 29 residential services in the Windsor neighborhood. The project also includes approximately 3,170 linear feet of new 8-inch water line in several residential streets, and the reconnection of 34 residential water services. Last, all roads within the project area will receive a two-inch overlay with new pavement to blend with existing curb and gutter.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right-of-way, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 150 working days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 3 general contractors. Bids were opened on May 20, 2004. Cash Construction Company, Ltd. submitted the lowest of 3 bids received:

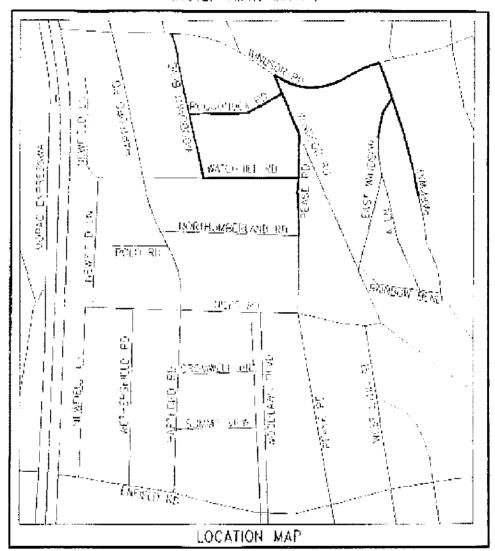

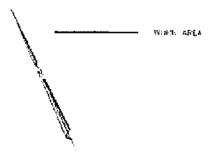
