SUBJECT: Authorize execution of amendment No. 2 to increase the interlocal agreement between the City of Austin and NEW MEXICO STATE PURCHASING AGENT (NMSPA) to participate in the Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) for the purchase of servers, laptops, desktops, monitors, extended warranties and internal parts in an amount not to exceed \$3,360,589, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$11,429,639. The City is in the final extension option of this agreement which ends on September 2, 2004.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$830,451 is available in fiscal year 2003-04 Operating Budgets; \$149,800 is available in Grant Funding; and \$2,392,890 is available in Capital Budgets, of various City Departments.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION: 7/19/2001 Council approved interlocal agreement in an amount not to exceed \$2,225,070, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$1,017,500 per option, for a total agreement not to exceed \$4,260,070.

1/10/2002 Council approved Amendment No. 1 to increase the interlocal agreement in an amount not to exceed \$1,977,480 for a revised amount not to exceed \$4,202,550 and increase each of the two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$915,750, for a revised amount not to exceed \$1,933,250 per option, for a revised total agreement not to exceed \$8,069,050.


This amendment will increase the authorization for the WSCA contract by \$3,460,589 to allow departments to purchase budgeted computer hardware through the end of the contract term on September 2, 2004. The contract provides a minimum discount of 8.5% and currently includes four computer manufacturers, Dell, HP, IBM and Gateway.

The increase in the City's spending authority for this contract is needed either to implement or to continue key projects that have been approved through the budget process and are underway such as the following:

Major Server Projects:

Consolidating applications and data from across the City onto a common operating environment will allow the City to gain efficiencies by sharing resources including hardware, software, personnel and a common knowledge base.

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- CTM will expand their SAN (Storage Area Network) to consolidate database storage for several citywide applications. The high-speed special-purpose network will interconnect different kinds of data storage devices with associated data servers on behalf of a larger network of users to consolidate database storage for citywide applications including AMANDA (replacing PIER), AFS3 (upgrade to the financial system which begins in June, SIRSI (Library) and Banner (Human Resources).
- Austin Water Utility is in the process of consolidation of servers and user data with a SAN upgrade to have capacity for digital TV inspection data(warranty ending, increased requirements, technological upgrades)
- SAN for Austin Energy (completed last fall), and additional server consolidations and end of life replacements this year

PCs & laptops to support new software applications:

- AMANDA project implementation 150 laptop computers will be deployed to inspectors in the field who previously did not have access to this technology.
- Community Care Services Department's new Electronic Medical Records System will make use of 75 tablet based PCs not used in clinics before this time.
- The Patrol laptops are a high priority for APD. Officers are currently going into the field without this equipment and a cadet class will graduate on June 18th. These additional officers will require laptops to complete their officer training.

Purchase instead of lease:

- Some General Fund departments have planned, with the approval of the Budget Office and CTM, to purchase instead of lease desktop PCs in the current fiscal year.
- Library has budgeted to replace 123 desktop PCs this fiscal year. Other departments would like tlexibility to buy PCs without monitors to reuse existing monitors that are still functional.

Amendment No. 1 expanded the authorization for Grant and CIP funds that could not lease desktops and added additional funding authorization. This RCA requests that Council add authority for replacement or upgrade of monitors, hard drives, memory, compatible system, video and expansion boards, and extended warranties. City departments are retaining desktops, laptops and servers far longer than the 3-year standard warranty period. It is cost effective to upgrade them and extend their life. Extended warranties minimize downtime and protect the investment in hardware that is business critical.
