<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with EARTHTECH, INC., Austin, TX, for construction inspection services, including specialized tunnel inspection, and ongoing traffic management support for the Austin Clean Water Program, in the amount of \$7,374,750 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$19,951,505.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$7,374,750 is included in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

The City of Austin developed the Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP) to achieve compliance with an Administrative Order, received in April 1999 from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, to eliminate overflows in the City of Austin's wastewater collection system. Total compliance with the Administrative Order must be achieved no later than December 31, 2007. Earth Tech, Inc., was hired in October 2001 to provide program management consultant (PMC) services, including design and construction management for improvements to the wastewater collection system. Design is now complete on approximately thirty-two (32) projects. It is anticipated that approximately twenty-three (23) of these ACWP projects will start construction in 2004, and twenty-four (24) in 2005.

It has been anticipated since the inception of the ACWP that as the number of projects in construction increased, at some point the available capacity of the City's Public Works Department Construction Inspection staff to adequately inspect these projects would be exceeded. It is estimated that point will be reached in mid 2004. Therefore supplemental inspection services will be required.

This proposed Amendment will provide for these supplemental general construction inspection services, through the completion of the ACWP in 2007, as well as specialized tunnel inspection services for the two large diameter ACWP tunnel projects (the Shoal Creek Tunnel and the Little Walnut Creek Tunnel). This amendment also includes the ongoing management and maintenance of a GIS-based traffic management website for ACWP projects through the end of 2005. This website is currently being
