SUBJECT: Authorize execution of change order # 10 to the construction contract with CADENCE MCSHANE CORPORATION, Austin, TX, for additional steel material and installation, for the George Washington Carver Museum and Cultural Center and Carver Branch Library Expansion, in the amount of \$53,476, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$10,470,432.61.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$995 is available in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Approved Capital Budget of Library Department; and funding in the amount of \$52,481 is available in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Approved Capital Budget of the Parks and Recreation Department.

City of Austin voters approved the George Washington Carver Museum and Cultural Center and Carver Branch Library Expansion projects in the November 1998 bond election as part of Proposition No. 4. The current museum and library are located in a campus-like setting at Kealing Park. This expansion project will enhance this campus by preserving the park environment. The community members and neighborhood groups participated in the design process. Both facilities are scheduled to open in fiscal year 2005.

The scope of this project included expansion to the existing museum and cultural center and library buildings and associated site work. Construction is nearing completion for installation of furniture, furnishings and equipment. Contract documents included steel allowance for miscellaneous steel materials and installation. The Contractor was tracking this allowance during construction. The Contractor had informed the City that the allowance seemed adequate to cover the additions of steel angels, tubes and other miscellaneous parts. When all steel calculations were reconciled, more steel was installed in the project. The current change order includes the cost of added steel materials and installation.

Original Contract amount was \$9,973,600 and contingency amount was \$400,000 making an approved

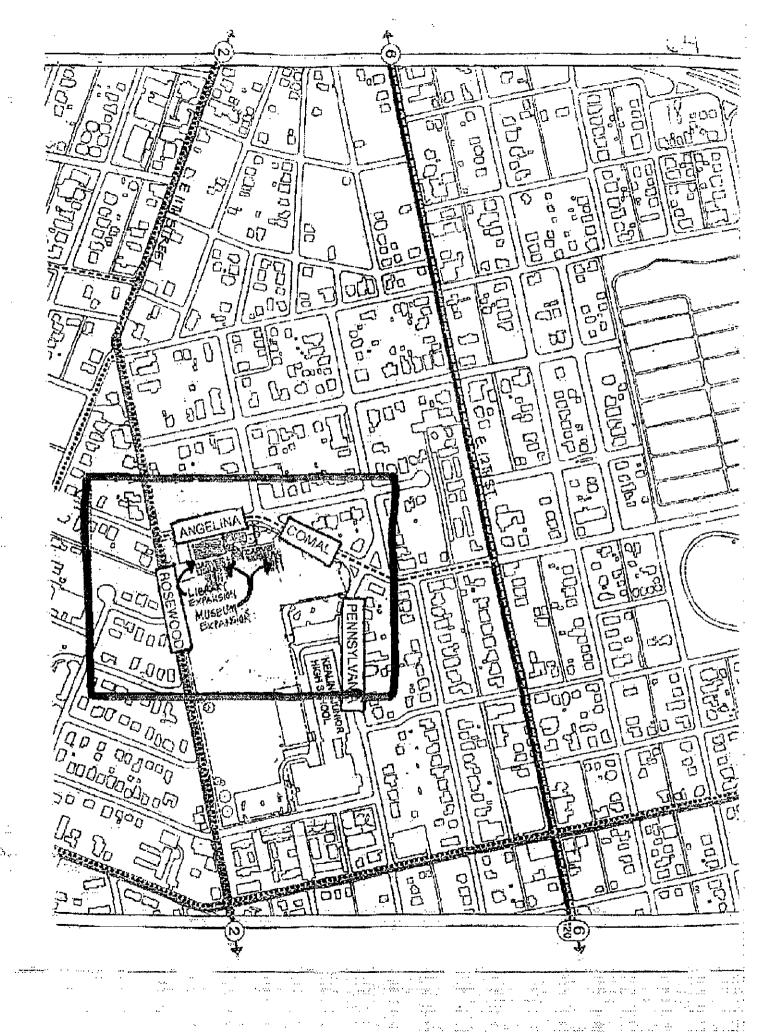
