**PURCHASING:** Lowest two bids of four bids received.

MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with 49 CFR, Part 26 of the Code of Federal Regulations (Disadvantage Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

These contracts will provide demolition services for the Public Works Department in support of the Noise Mitigation Program at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. After properties are acquired by the City of Austin, structures on properties identified as "not salvageable" will be demolished in an expeditious manner to prevent vandalism from occurring on the vacant properties. Some structures contain asbestos, which must be mitigated. Disturbance of asbestos containing materials is regulated by the Texas Department of Health and removal activities will be performed by a State of Texas licensed asbestos abatement contractor under the asbestos abatement contract. It will be necessary to remove asbestos containing materials prior to the sale of select structures and/or the demolition of structures on properties acquired as part of the Noise Mitigation Program.

The two lowest bidders will work on specific groups of residential structures. Work will range from the demolition of mobile homes to the demolition of slab-on-grade structures. The contractors will also follow the City of Austin procedures for the proper abandonment of existing septic tanks.

In accordance with the City of Austin's commitment to prevent pollution, the City is actively working toward minimizing the waste generated at all facilities. The contractors will be expected to make every reasonable effort to minimize the waste streams resulting from the demolition activities.

Brush, construction-demolition waste (which includes all materials that are directly or indirectly the by-products of construction work or that result from demolition of buildings and other structures, including, but not limited to, paper, cartons, gypsum board, wood, excelsior, rubber, and plastics), and/or rubbish that is free of putrescible (and free of household) wastes shall be disposed at the City of Austin Landfill

It will be necessary to bid out an asbestos abatement contract and a demolition services contract for other similarly-situated properties to be acquired in the near future. Asbestos-containing materials will also have to be removed prior to the sale of select structures and/or the demolition of structures on other properties acquired as part of the Noise Mitigation Program.
