SUBJECT: Approve issuance of a letter of intent for a rebate in the amount of \$45,524 to the AWARE HOUSE, Austin, TX, for the installation of a solar photovoltaic system at their facility located at 3804 South Congress Avenue.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION: Austin Energy Strategic Plan, December 2003.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: Recommended by the Electric Utility Commission and the Resource Management Commission.

Austin Energy requests authorization to issue a letter of intent for a rebate in the amount of \$45,524 to The Aware House for the installation of a solar photovoltaic system, in accordance with the City of Austin's Solar Rebate Program guidelines. The program is one element of Austin Energy's comprehensive Strategic Plan, approved in December 2003.

The Aware House is a 20,000 square foot mixed-use building located at 3804 South Congress Avenue. The solar photovoltaic equipment to be installed will provide a yearly energy savings of an estimated 14,600 kWh.

The City will not exceed the maximum incentive offer should the final installed measures be eligible for a higher rebate at the time of the inspection due to changes in quantity or efficiency of equipment.
