**SUBJECT:** Approve the issuance of a letter of intent for a rebate in the amount of \$100,000 to the LOWER COLORADO RIVER AUTHORITY (LCRA) for the installation of a solar photovoltaic system at their facility located at 3505 Montopolis, Austin, TX.

Austin Energy requests authorization to issue a letter of intent for a rebate in the amount of \$100,000 to the LCRA for the installation of a solar photovoltaic system at their Montopolis facility, in accordance with the City of Austin's Solar Rebate Program guidelines. The program is one element of Austin Energy's comprehensive Strategic Plan approved in December 2003.

The Lower Colorado River Authority is a 20,000 square foot office building located at 3505 Montopolis. The solar photovoltaic equipment to be installed will provide a yearly energy savings of an estimated 34,958 kWh.

The City will not exceed the maximum incentive offer should the final installed measures be eligible for a higher rebate at the time of the inspection due to changes in quantity or efficiency of equipment.
