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The request for the vacation of a portion of University Avenue (2900 Block) has been submitted by Larry Foster, on behalf of the Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary.

The area being requested for vacation will allow the Seminary more flexibility in its master plan. In exchange for the right of way, the Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary will deed a 25-foot strip of land to the City of Austin, Parks and Recreation Department for a future bicycle/pedestrian trail. All affected departments and franchise holders have reviewed this request and recommended approval, subject to the area being retained as a drainage and public utility easement.

Property owners within 300 feet of the area to be vacated were notified on June 28, 2004. An objection has been received from George F. Allen to this proposed vacation as a result of the notification.

No revenue will be generated to the City of Austin for the vacation of the requested right of way due to the exchange.



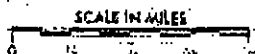
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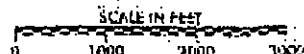
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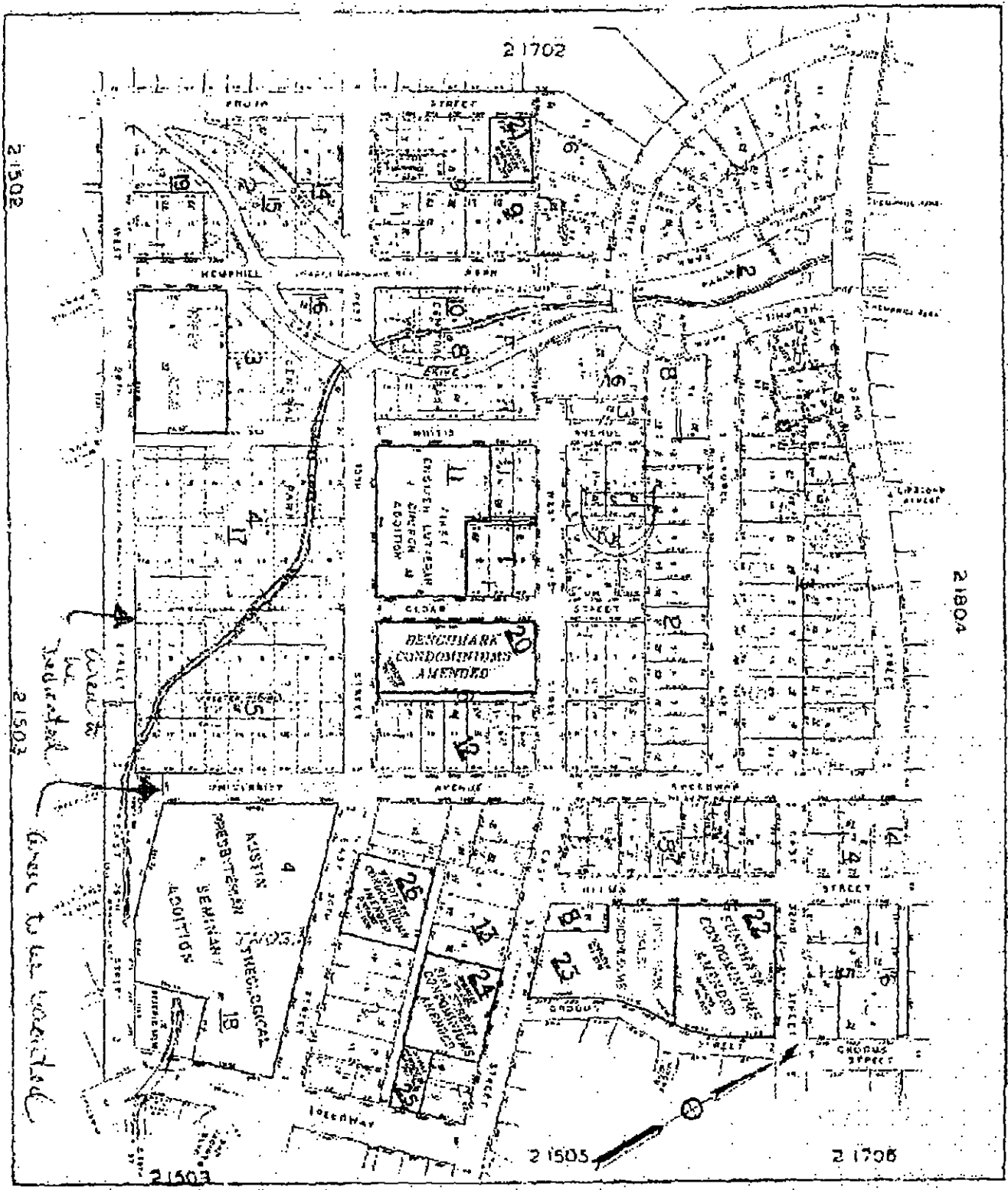
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**ORDINANCE NO. 04**

**BLOCKY**

Mr. Larry Foster, with Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary, described this vacation request. He showed a map of the property, and stated the plans came from the North University Neighborhood Association (NUNA). The two have been working together for a number of years as NUNA put this campus area massive rezoning vision together. The Seminary also has planned in the very near future, probably in the next two years, to re-do the old residential housing area.

NUNA proposed a pedestrian bike path from 30<sup>th</sup> Street, through the park, and eventually connecting up to Whitis. This would be an attractive pedestrian route and could take the bike traffic off Speedway and Guadalupe. The Seminary will give the City 25 linear feet of their property running from 30<sup>th</sup> Street to an old City right-of-way, a street plotted in 1910 that was never built, in exchange for the vacation of University Drive. When the Seminary redoes the housing, they would like to move it away from the bike and pedestrian path that will be lighted 24 hours a day.
