**SUBJECT:** Ratify execution of a construction contract with McLEAN CONSTRUCTION, LTD., Killeen TX, for the Austin Clean Water Program - Shoal Creek Wastewater Improvements, Seton/West 34<sup>th</sup> Street Wastewater Line project in an amount not to exceed \$223,403.80.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding is included in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: Recommended by the Water and Wastewater Commission.

**PURCHASING:** Health or Safety Purchase Exemption. Lowest bid of four received.

MBE / WBE: 81.22% MBE and 2.4% WBE subcontractor participation.

This construction project is a result of a request from Seton Hospital for a new wastewater service in West 34<sup>th</sup> Street. The Austin Water Utility agreed to provide the necessary improvements, and this scope was incorporated into a bid package with other Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP) improvements in the Shoal Creek vicinity. Bids were taken on the package in February, 2004, but all bids were rejected due to technical deficiencies in the bid responses. Since the wastewater line for Seton was needed prior to June 1, 2004, an Emergency Affidavit was signed on April 15 allowing for immediate award of the wastewater line in West 34<sup>th</sup> to serve Seton hospital as authorized under Section 252.022(a)(2) of the Texas Local Government Code, which exempts the normal procurement procedures in order to preserve or protect the public health and safety of the City's residents. Bids were obtained utilizing an accelerated bid process. A contract was executed with the lowest responsible bidder and notice to proceed was issued on May 6, 2004. The work achieved substantial completion by June 1 as requested by Seton in regard to the opening of the expansion of the Seton hospital complex.

The improvements consist of 898 linear feet of 12-inch wastewater line and 8 manholes, in the 1300 block of West 34<sup>th</sup> Street and remainder in 3300 block of Shoal Creek Blvd. Pavement repairs are underway.

The contract allows 30 calendar days for substantial completion of this project, which was achieved.

Bid documents were distributed to 10 general contractors. Bids were opened on April 20, 2004. McLEAN CONSTRUCTION, LTD. submitted the lowest of 4 bids received:

SUBJECT: Ratification of construction contract for the Installation of 12-inch Wastewater Line for Seton Hospital

Seton Hospital, located on West 38<sup>th</sup> Street, is constructing an expansion. Seton requested a new City wastewater line in West 34<sup>th</sup> Street to provide wastewater service from both the hospital expansion and the existing hospital. Austin Water Utility (AWU) agreed to construct the necessary new line, and requested the Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP) to develop a design for the proposed line. The proposed line will be at a lower depth than the existing City line in West 34<sup>th</sup> and the hospital will generate more flow than the existing line can convey. The ACWP design called for approximately 898 linear feet of 12-inch wastewater line, plus 8 manholes, with about half to be constructed in West 34<sup>th</sup> Street and remainder on Shoal Creek Boulevard.

Bids were taken on the package in February, 2004, but all bids were rejected due to technical deficiencies in the bid responses. Since the wastewater line for Seton was needed prior to June 1, 2004, an Affidavit of Public Health need was signed on April 15 allowing for immediate award of the wastewater line in West 34<sup>th</sup> to serve Scton hospital. A contract was executed with the lowest responsible bidder and a notice to proceed was issued on May 6, 2004. The work achieved substantial completion by June 1 as requested by Seton in regard to the opening of the expansion of the Scton hospital complex. The contract allowed 30 calendar days for substantial completion of this project, which was achieved.

Bid documents were distributed to 10 general contractors. Bids were opened on April 20, 2004. McLean Construction, LTD. submitted the lowest of 4 bids received in the amount of \$ 223,403.80.


