<u>Background</u>

The goal of the Community Immunizations program is to prevent, control, and eliminate vaccinepreventable diseases by providing and administering biologicals, promoting immunizations, conducting vaccine-preventable disease surveillance, assuring vaccine coverage levels, and applying principles of epidemiology and outbreak control measures within budgetary constraints with special emphasis on accelerating interventions to improve coverage of children two (2) years of age or younger.

The additional \$49,941 in grant funds will be used to meet the performance measures originally approved for the fiscal year 2003-2004 Operating budget and will not result in the provision of additional units of services; but will reduce the general fund amount of grant support for the Immunization Program.

Performance Measures

- Monitor adverse events following vaccination to detect and address unusual or unexpected events.
- Administer vaccines and ensure that individuals are linked to health care providers who provide immunizations.
- Perform population-based assessments to measure vaccine-preventable diseases.
- Inform and educate the public about vaccines, delivery of vaccination services and vaccinepreventable diseases.

Outcomes/Outputs

• Percent of children two (2) years of age or younger that are appropriately immunized. Goal:



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73.9%

- Conduct annual assessments in 100% of local health department sites, sub-contracted entities, and Woman, Infants and Children (WIC) clinics.
- Investigate 100% of suspected hepatitis B infections in pregnant women to assure appropriate treatment and follow-up.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 030909-01 TO APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$49,941 in grant funds from the Texas Department of Health, Immunization Division.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Health and Human Services Department Special Revenue Fund Operating Budget of Ordinance No. 030909-01 to appropriate \$49,941 in grant funds to meet performance measures in the Community Immunization Program.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
