<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of a construction contract with LAUGHLIN-THYSSEN, LTD., Houston, TX, for the Del Valle Service to Annexed Areas Water and Wastewater Improvements Area 3 project in the amount of \$4,695,947.20 plus a \$469,595 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$5,165,542.20.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$5,165,542.20 is included in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

<u>PURCHASING</u>: Lowest bid of three received.

MBE / WBE: 16.93% MBE and 7.24% WBE subcontractor participation.

The Del Valle Annexation Area, an area of approximately 1200 acres, was annexed for Limited Purposes in September 1999 and for Full Purpose in September 2001. State Law mandates that construction of water and wastewater infrastructure begins within two years of the annexation and be completed within four and one half years of annexation. The Water and Wastewater Service Area Master Plan identifies the infrastructure required to provide a water distribution system, including adequate water service for fire protection, and a wastewater collection system for the area.

The Work of this Contract comprises the construction of approximately 13,300 linear feet of 8, 12 and 15inch diameter wastewater lines; bores with 8-inch carrier pipe with 15-inch steel casing, 12-inch carrier pipe with 20-inch steel casing and 15-inch carrier pipe with 24-inch steel casing; wastewater manholes; and wastewater service line stubs. The work also includes approximately 27,700 linear feet of 6, 8, 12 and 16-inch diameter water lines; bores with 8-inch diameter carrier pipe and 16-inch steel casing and 16-inch diameter carrier pipe and 30-inch steel casing; water service connections; fire hydrants; drain valves; automatic air release valves; and gate valves. In addition, the work includes street replacement; and restoration of existing structures and vegetation as shown on the construction drawings. Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right-of-way, approximately 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 275 calendar days for substantial completion of this project with an additional 60 calendar days for final completion.

Bid documents were distributed to seven general contractors. Bids were opened on July 22, 2004. Laughlin-Thyssen, Ltd. submitted the lowest of three bids received:


