
Construction Contract CITY OF AUSTIN RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION



SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a construction contract with KEYSTONE CONSTRUCTION, INC., Austin, TX, for the Austin Clean Water Program - Upper Shoal Creek/Upper Hancock Branch at Hardy Drive wastewater improvements project in an amount not to exceed \$225,794.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Fundingis included in the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: Recommended by the Water and Wastewater Commission.

<u>PURCHASING</u>: Lowest bid of three received.

MBE / WBE: 23.60% MBE and 6.85% WBE subcontractor participation.

This construction contract will provide for wastewater collection system improvements along Hardy Drive adjacent to Burnet Road in the Crestview neighborhood. The improvements will replace deteriorated and undersized wastewater collection facilities. This project is part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP), which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows.

The proposed improvements include the installation of 873 linear feet of 12-inch sanitary sewer and construction of six (6) new manholes along Hardy Drive from Richcreek Road to Hardy Circle. The contract allows 105 working days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 5 general contractors. Bids were opened on July 8, 2004. KEYSTONE CONSTRUCTION, INC. submitted the lowest of 3 bids received:

Keystone Construction, Inc., Austin, TX	\$225,794.00
McLean Construction, Inc., Killeen, TX	\$274,327.00
C.C. Carlton Industries, Ltd., Austin, TX	\$298,164.00

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for seven (7) areas of subcontracting opportunities listed below. Project participation goals stated in the solicitation were 21.13% MBE and 6.50% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$225,794.00:

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

THIRD BIDDER - C.C. Carlton Industries, Ltd., Austin, TX - \$298,164.00 71.70% Non M/WBE prime participation; 21.47% MBE; 6.82% WBE; 0.00% Non M/WBE subcontractor participation.
