ORDINANCE NO. 040805-

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING "BARTON CREEK AND BARTON SPRINGS DAY" AND WAIVING BARTON SPRINGS POOL FEES.

WHEREAS, August 8, 2004 has been declared as "Barton Creek and Barton Springs Day"; and

WHEREAS, the City of Austin joins its citizens in its civic appreciation of Barton Creek and Barton Springs; and

WHEREAS; waiver of Barton Springs Pool fees would assist in promoting a public appreciation of the Barton Creek and Barton Springs: **NOW, TIHEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. August 8, 2004 is declared "Barton Creek and Barton Springs Day".

PART 2. The City Manager is directed to waive Barton Springs Pool admission fees for August 8, 2004.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to waive fees expeditiously constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public pease, health and safety.
