The City of Austin is certified by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to regulate the rates charged by a cable franchise holder for basic cable services, equipment, (e.g. converter boxes, cable access cards, etc.) and installation services until and unless the FCC determines that "effective competition" to cable services exists in the city. Although Time Warner filed a petition with the FCC to declare Austin subject to "effective competition" in May 2001, the FCC has not yet ruled on the merits of that claim.

Article 11, Section 6 of the City Charter requires the Council to conduct a public hearing before considering an ordinance that regulating the rates, charges and fares of a franchise holder. This item sets the public hearing for September 2, 2004, at 6:00 p.m.
