SUBJECT: Approve a resolution approving contracts for Cultural Arts Services for the Fiscal Year 2004-2005.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$2,557,552 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Proposed Budget for the Cultural Arts Fund for cultural arts contracts which also maintains the required 10% reserve of \$301,374.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: Recommended and adopted by the Austin Arts Commission.

Council is requested to approve cultural arts funding in the amount of \$2,557,552 as listed in Volume 2 of the proposed 2004-2005 budget. This amount has been allocated to support applicants to the Cultural Arts Funding Programs who received a score of 70 or greater in the peer review process. It also maintains the Zachary Scott Theater maintenance at \$60,000.

2004-2005 is the first funding year of the new Cultural Arts Funding Programs. Adopted by Council April 15, 2004, the new guidelines reestablished the peer review process; implemented four specific funding programs based on organization size and project budget; opened the process to both new and previous applicants; and provided for the formulaic allocation of funds based on the applicant's score.

A total of 198 applications were received requesting \$6,716,653 in cultural arts funding. Of these, eight were not recommended for funding by the panels or the Austin Arts Commission based on score, and one was withdrawn by the applicant. 45 peer review panelists convened in 13 separate public review meetings to conduct the application review, provide constructive feedback to applicants and score the applications. The panels were made up of 26 individuals from Austin and 19 from other Texas cities including Dallas, Houston, San Antonio, Round Rock, Pflugerville, and Kingsville.

The Cultural Arts Funding Programs require a minimum score of 70 in the panel process to be eligible for funding. The Austin Arts Commission developed the funding plan based on this requirement. Those applicants who scored less than 70 were not considered for funding.

The funding subcommittee of the Austin Arts Commission worked with Cultural Arts Division staff in the development of a funding plan and formulaic allocation of funds. To assist in this process, the Deputy Director of the Texas Commission on the Arts was assigned by the Chair of the Arts Commission to participate as an independent monitor/advisor. Deliberations on the funding plan and related formulas, by the Arts Commission, were conducted in a blind process where the names of individual applicants were
