<u>MBE / WBE:</u> This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract is for the purchase of two portable highway advisory radio systems (IIAR) for the Watershed Protection and Development Review Department (formerly TPSD). Each unit is a portable solar-powered or battery-operated advisory radio station that can be placed along thoroughfares to inform motorists to tune to certain radio frequencies for information about roadway and weather conditions. This will alert motorists about upcoming work zones, road closings, inclement weather, traffic, and other pertinent information. These units broadcast in the AM band from 530 kHz to 1700 kHz.

The HAR units will support the business plan goals of Watershed Protection and Development Review to provide safe and efficient multi-model transportation infrastructure and optimize utilization of existing roadway capacity.

There is a companion item for four portable changeable message signs to be used for traffic control purposes during traffic accidents, construction, special events, and any other incidents that may require special traffic control devices. The PCM signs are electrically operated by solar-powered battery and include a microwave detection option (speed radar).
