<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with BARNES ARCHITECTS, Austin, TX, for additional services related to the explosion on November 3, 2003, during construction of the North Service Center, in the amount of \$621,769 for a total contract amount not to exceed \$3,229,584.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$621,769 is available in the Fiscal Year 2002-2003 Amended Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

<u>PURCHASING</u>: Amendment to an existing professional services agreement.

MBE / WBE: 24.57% MBE and 20.41% WBE subcontractor participation to date.

The North Service Center, located at 10414 McKalla Place, is a joint use project for the Austin Water Utility, the Public Works Department, and the Financial and Administrative Services Department (Fleet Services Division). It will provide facilities for:

- · Austin Water Utility's North Line Maintenance, Central Stores and Meter Shop
- A facility for Street and Bridge operations currently based at the Harold Court and Kramer Lane facilities
- A facility for the traffic lane markings section of the Public Works Department which is currently housed at Harold Court
- A 16-bay vehicle service facility to replace the Fleet Services' current facility at Kramer Lane

The project has been delayed due to the explosion that occurred during excavation for a storm sewer line at the project site on November 3, 2003.

Excavation to remediate the site is underway and is anticipated to be completed in October 2004.



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The construction contract with the original contractor has been terminated because the submitted cost for continuing with the construction contract was greater than the limit allowable under State law, therefore, the project needs to be re-bid. In order to re-bid the project, the consultant is modifying the construction documents to take into account previously performed work, addenda, change orders, changed conditions due to the explosion review and inventory of construction materials on hand. The proposed supplemental amendment is for the remainder of the construction phase services to complete the project and warranty phase services. These services cannot be accommodated with the remaining authorization because:

- The previous construction effort absorbed a disproportionate amount of construction phase fees because it included the bulk of the submittal process, which is time-intensive.
- Over two years have elapsed since the hourly rates were last established and an increase in those rates is justifiable and allowable under the contract.

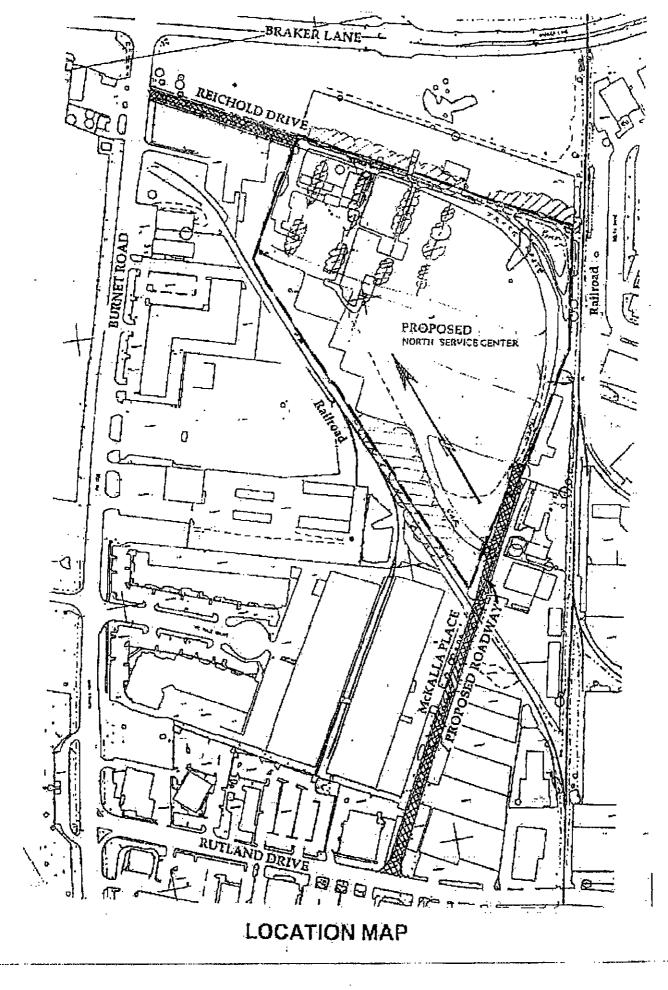
