
Change order CITY OF AUSTIN RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION



SUBJECT: Authorize execution of change order # 2 to the construction contract with THE BARR COMPANY, AIA, (MBE/FH 44.67%) Austin, TX for the Spicewood Springs Branch Library Site Work Improvements Re-Bid in the amount of \$27,517.53, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$455,005.68.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$455,005.68 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Capital Budget of the Library Department.

PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION: Resolution authorizing the filing of eminent domain proceedings to acquire the fee simple interest in Lot 5, Town and Country Village Addition, Section 4, Phase 1, Williamson County, Texas, owned by Nieman Properties, for the Spicewood Springs Branch Library Expansion, was approved November 4, 1999; resolution awarding the construction contract on September 9, 2004.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: Conditional Use Permit approved by the Zoning and Platting Commission.

PURCHASING: N/A

MBE / WBE: 0.59% MBE and 1.09% WBE subcontractor participation to date.

The expansion of the Spicewood Springs Branch Library is a project funded by the 1998 Bond Election. The facility is located at 8637 Spicewood Springs Road.

The work under this contract provides for site improvements at the Spicewood Springs Branch Library in preparation for the future remodel and addition to be completed in October 2006. The remodel and addition was originally scheduled for completion in January 2005. However, due to operating budget constraints it was postponed by Council. The site improvements include a complete parking layout with an increase of fifty parking spaces, site lighting, realignment of a driveway with Parliament Place, water quality improvements and landscaping. The site improvements will provide a measure of relief by providing more and safer parking for the library patrons in the period prior to the library building renovation and expansion.

The change order is necessary to address additional quantities of unforeseen excavation materials which need to be removed from the site; increase in water utility lines and associated excavation; the addition of a Unit Price item which was not included in the bid form, and additional chain link fencing and tri-dikes at the request of the Environmental Inspector.
