<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of a construction contract with MCLEAN CONSTRUCTION, LTD. KILLEEN, TX, for the Austin Clean Water Program: Little Walnut/Buttermilk at Colony Creek North and Fort Branch/Westminster projects in the amount of \$1,348,477 plus a \$134,847.70 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,483,324.70

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$1,483,324.70 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

**<u>PURCHASING</u>**: Lowest bid of five received.

MBE / WBE: 19.854 % MBE and 10.17 % WBE subcontractor participation.

This construction contract will provide for sanitary sewer improvements in a generally commercial area north of US 183 and east of Loop 1. The improvements are intended to replace existing undersized lines and eliminate the wastewater overflows that have occurred. Also included in this contract is a 350-foot segment of sanitary sewer to be bored under Fort Branch from Westminster Street to Trafalgar Street that will replace an existing wastewater line that has been damaged and caused overflows in the creek. Both project segments are part of the Austin Water Utility's Austin Clean Water Program (ACWP), which was developed to respond to the requirements of the Environmental Protection Agency's Administrative Order regarding Sanitary Sewer Overflows.

The proposed improvements include the installation of approximately 840 linear feet of 18-inch sanitary sewer and 2,675 linear feet of 15-inch sanitary sewer. Streets impacted by construction include Northgate Boulevard, Metric Boulevard, Old McNeil Road, Burnet Road, Foster Lane, Westminster Street and Trafalgar Street. Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions when working in the right-of-way, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 215 calendar days for final completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 9 general contractors. Bids were opened on September 9, 2004. The McLean Construction, Ltd. submitted the lowest of 5 bids received:





