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The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has entered into a Developer Agreement with Lone Star Infrastructure, JV (LSI) to construct the Central Texas Turnpike Project identified as State Highway 130 (SH 130). SH 130 is a 91 mile long toll road that extends southward from the Interstate Highway 35 (IH-35) – SH 195 intersection north of Georgetown to IH-10 near Seguin. LSI will be constructing the toll road including utility relocations along the route of SH 130. LSI will pay for the design, construction and inspection of any adjustments of existing utilities necessary to construct the toll road along the SH 130 route. The design and construction of these adjustments will follow Austin Water Utility Standards.

LSI has identified six areas where adjustments to existing water and wastewater lines will be required. Should Austin Water Utility (AWU) determine there is a need to upgrade the existing utilities or place new lines in or across the SH 130 Rights-of-Way, LSI will design and construct the facilities, as betterment, for AWU at AWU's expense.
