<u>MBE / WBE:</u> This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract is for the purchase of a Data Acquisition System (DAS) for analog inputs on Unit 2 at the Decker Creek Power Station. The DAS monitors temperatures of metal tubes in the boiler. There are approximately 200 analog inputs currently being recorded on old strip-chart recorders that are now obsolete. This new DAS is a modern, micro-process based system that will work in conjunction with the new Distributed Control System (DCS). The DCS is real-time plant-wide network of components that monitors and controls parameters such as temperature, pressure, flow, and valve position. It is the means by which plant operators operate the plant equipment and generating units. It will allow for more effective monitoring of boiler tube metal temperatures. The system will also provide better alarm capabilities in the event of overheating.
