**SUBJECT:** Approve a resolution authorizing the filing of eminent domain proceedings for the Austin Clean Water Program: Little Walnut/Buttermilk - North Capital Drive project to acquire a 0.037 acre permanent wastewater line easement, a 0.350 acre temporary working space easement, and a 0.309 acre temporary ingress and egress easement out of a 24.001 acre tract of land in the John Applegait Survey No. 58, Abs. 29, in Travis County, TX, in the amount of \$21,439. The owner of the property interests sought to be acquired is TEXRUN ENTERPRISES, INC., Austin, TX. The property is located along the north side of East Rundberg Lane, east of Oriole Drive, south of Brownie Drive, and west of IH-35, also known as 0 Longspur Boulevard East.

The design plans for the Austin Clean Water Program: Little Walnut/Buttermilk - North Capital Drive project require acquisition of a permanent wastewater line easement, a temporary working space easement, and a temporary ingress and egress easement on land located along the north side of East Rundberg Lane, east of Oriole Drive, south of Brownie Drive and west of IH-35, also known as 0 Longspur Boulevard East.

The City of Austin has attempted to purchase the three easements from the landowner; however, the parties have been unable to agree on an appropriate price. The Law Department is requesting authorization to file a lawsuit in eminent domain on behalf of the City of Austin.


