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<u>SUBJECT</u>: Authorize execution of a 60-month supply/service agreement with INVENSYS SYSTEMS, INCORPORATED, Foxboro, MA, for power plant boiler control system parts and maintenance services in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$333,333 is available in the Approved Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Operating Budget of Austin Energy. Funding for the remaining 50-months of the original contract period is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

<u>MBE / WBE:</u> This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This supply/service agreement is for the purchase of software, engineering services, field services, and spare parts to repair, maintain, and upgrade the existing Distributed Control Systems (DCS) at all of the Austin Energy power plants. The DCS monitors boiler controls, burner management, data acquisition and turbine controls. Decker, Holly, and Sand Hill power plants have Invensys (Foxboro) DCS control systems installed. In order to maintain the control systems, spare parts and services are needed and can only be obtained from the original equipment manufacturer, Invensys (Foxboro).
