## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 040624-52, RELATED TO INTERIM DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS FOR A TWO-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL USE AND SECONDARY APARTMENT SPECIAL USE, TO EXTEND THE EXPIRATION DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Part 5 of Ordinance No. 040624-52 is amended to read as follows:

This ordinance expires at 12:01 a.m. on <u>December 20, 2004</u> [November 20, 2004].

# PART 2. EMERGENCY.

PASSED AND APPROVED

The Council finds that the continued development of high occupancy uses in proximity to single-family residential development would impede the Council's efforts to examine land use issues concerning high occupancy uses and that this constitutes an emergency. Because of the emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
