**SUBJECT:** Authorize acceptance of \$110,649 in Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) grant funds for the construction of traffic signal improvements on LP 360 from US 183 to RM 2222; and amend Ordinance No. 040913-01, the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Amended Capital Budget of the Public Works Department, by appropriating \$110,649 in grant funds and creating a new project called "LP 360: US 183 to RM 2222 Signals Improvement Project".

**AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING:** Total project cost is \$138,311. 80% of project costs will be provided from TxDOT grant funds. Funding for the remaining 20% is available in Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Amended Capital Budget of the Public Works Department.

**PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION:** On August 7, 2003 the Council approved a resolution authorizing the City Manager to submit roadway, bicycle and pedestrian-related projects for consideration by Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) for Federal funding under the Federal Surface Transportation Program Metropolitan Mobility (STP MM) fund. That resolution included \$138,311 (\$110,649 in Federal grant funds and the City's 20% match of \$27,662) for the LP 360: US 183 to RM 2222 Signals Improvement Project.

The LP 360: US 183 to RM 2222 Signals Improvement Project is part of the Transportation Engineering Division, Traffic Signal Section program to provide safe and efficient multi-modal transportation. The Project involves installation of aerial and underground cable and control equipment to establish synchronization, facilitate communication and give remote control of traffic signals along the arterial to the City's Traffic Management Center. The Project will aid the City in its goals to reduce air pollution and traffic congestion by improving traffic signal infrastructure and maximizing synchronization.
