MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore no goals were established for this solicitation.

This project was developed in order to complete a priority project requested by the Department of Aviation. The project includes furnishing all tools, labor, materials, equipment, and miscellaneous items necessary for the complete installation of one (1) new self-priming, two speed pump to transfer water from an existing concrete holding pond to an existing filtration pond or to sanitary waste. The ancillary work includes the modification of an existing electrical panel, routing of underground conduit and conductors to the pump starter, installation of float switches to the pump starter control circuit and to two (2) sluice gate controllers for gate control.

This project is the second stage of improvements to the concrete holding pond. The first stage of improvements was completed in July. That work included installation of a 60 mil High Density Polyethlene (HDPE) membrane over the entire concrete holding pond in order to provide secure containment of water runoff from the Cargo Apron Area in the event of glycol use on the Cargo Apron during freezing weather events.

The contract allows 60 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 7 general contractors. Bids were opened on November 10, 2004. Muniz Concrete and Contracting Company submitted the lowest responsive bid of three (3) bids received:
