AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$2,829,360 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Operating Budgets of the various City Departments. Funding in the amount of \$1,564,500 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Capital Budget of Austin Energy. Funding in the amount of \$2,526,607 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Capital Budget of various other City Departments. Funding in the amount of \$107,600 is available in Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Grant Budgets. Funding for the extension option is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

This agreement is for the purchase of the categories of computer hardware specified on the table below and maintenance for that equipment through the State of Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) Go DiRect program.

DIR issues competitive RFPs for computer hardware and is able to obtain competitive pricing due to volume purchases. DIR has actively worked to establish contracts with State HUB resellers at the same price and terms it would get if it bought directly from the manufacturer. DIR has aggressively negotiated special offers with some of the larger manufacturers such as Dell and HP by guaranteeing a minimum purchase of a certain desktop configuration and passing the savings on to every entity that is eligible to use the contract. Over the course of this authorization, DIR may add and delete contracts from its Go Direct program. A complete list of all the current DIR contracts can be easily accessed on its website.

Communications and Technology Management (CTM) reviews and approves technology purchases for all General Fund and Support Services Departments. When purchasing IT equipment through the DIR Go Direct Program, these departments must initiate purchase requests through CTM's "Helpdesk, IT Purchases" email address. These technology requests will undergo technology review to ensure compliance with CTM standards and technology fit with existing systems.


