<u>PURCHASING</u>: Best proposal of four proposals received.

<u>MBE / WBE</u>: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation

This contract is for the services of a part time Hearings Officer to adjudicate complaints from ratepayers based on the actions, policies and/or decisions of the City's utilities-Austin Energy, Austin Water Utility, Solid Waste Services, and the Austin Police Department (APD). The City's Utility Service Regulations require ratepayers' complaints to be heard and adjudicated in a fair, impartial, and equitable manner within a reasonable time frame. The Austin Police Department (APD) also plans to utilize the Hearings Officer to hear complaints from persons who are billed by APD for false alarms originating from residences and commercial establishments.

A Request for Proposals was issued on August 16, 2004, and four proposals were received. A review panel evaluated the proposals using criteria included in the solicitation. The review panel consisted of staff from Austin Energy, Austin Water Utility, Law, Police and Solid Waste Services.
