SUBJECT: Authorize an ordinance accepting additional grant funds from the Texas Department of Transportation Automobile Theft Prevention Authority in the amount of \$53,938 for the Auto Theft Interdiction Project in the Austin Police Department, amend the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Police Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance 040913-01 to appropriate these funds for a total grant amount of \$368,938.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$368,938 is available in Fiscal Year 2005-2006 (September 1, 2005 - August 31, 2006) from the Texas Department of Transportation Automobile Theft Prevention Authority. An in-kind match of \$426,646 is required and met through existing salary costs. Funding for the continued operation of this program is contingent upon available funding in the future budgets.

This action authorizes the City to accept and appropriate \$53,938 in additional grant renewal funding from the Texas Department of Transportation Automobile Theft Prevention Authority (ATPA), to continue the Auto Theft Interdiction Project within the Austin Police Department. Funding for this grant program is generated by the \$1.00 per motor vehicle fee paid each year by residents as they purchase car insurance. Appropriation of \$315,000 is currently included in the FY2005 Approved Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund. This council action increases the total grant appropriation to \$368,938.

The grant application continues funding for two full-time equivalent civilian positions (2 civilian FTEs) and three full-time detective positions (3 sworn FTEs). The grant also funds overtime costs for auto theft crime analysis and part of the operating costs associated with the program.

An in-kind match is required and will be included in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Operating Budget of the Austin Police Department. The in-kind match includes General Fund salaries and fringe costs associated with six detectives, and 50% of the sergeant and lieutenant in the Auto Thest Interdiction Unit (\$421,646) and sworn overtime for special operations (\$5,000). The total in-kind match for this program is \$426,646.

The goal of the Auto Theft Interdiction Project is to reduce the incidence of auto thefts in the City of Austin. Several strategies are employed to meet this goal: investigation, enforcement, prevention and education.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 040913-01 TO APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$53,938 in grant funds from the Texas Department of Transportation Automobile Theft Prevention Authority.
