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SUBJECT: Authorize the execution of an amendment to the Advance Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) for the Lance Armstrong Bikeway and payment of an amount not to exceed \$63,211.13 to TxDOT for the construction of the portion of the Bikeway in the right-of-way of IH-35 near 4th Street.

- 07/15/99 Council approved list of City of Austin Transportation Enhancement Applications,
- 10/26/00 Council approved Interlocal Agreement with TxDOT for the Austin Crosstown Bikeway (later renamed the Lance Armstrong Bikeway) awarded by the Statewide Transportation Enhancements Program in the amount of \$3,203,163.00;
- 12/14/00 Council authorized the negotiation and execution of a professional services agreement with Wilbur Smith Associates for preliminary design and construction phase services for the Bikeway.

This amendment to the Advance Funding Agreement addresses the construction of the section of the Lance Armstrong Bikeway that passes beneath IH-35 at 4th Street. The original agreement indicated that City of Austin forces would construct this portion of the bikeway. Under this amendment, TxDOT is responsible for that work.

To eliminate a duplication of construction work where certain improvements would be constructed under the Barrier Removal Project and then replaced by the Lance Armstrong Bikeway Project improvements, this section of the Lance Armstrong Bikeway design will be incorporated into the TxDOT Barrier Removal Project. TxDOT has agreed to incorporate the new design into the Barrier Removal Project if the City will fund that portion of the project. This amendment allows TxDOT to contract for construction of the portion of the Bikeway Project within its right-of-way at IH-35. The City of Austin will pay 100% of the cost. The not-to-be exceeded cost of the work is \$63,211.13.

ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT AMENDMENT #1



THIS AMENDMENT IS MADE BY AND BETWEEN the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the State, and the City of Austin, acting by and through their duly authorized officials, hereinafter called the Local Government.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State and the Local Government executed a contract on 13th day of December of 2000 to effectuate their agreement to complete the Austin Crosstown Bikeway Project; and,

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend that contract;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto, the State and the Local Government do agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

Article 1. Description of Amended Items

Section 10. Construction Responsibilities. Second sentence is voided and replaced with the following: The State will be responsible for the construction of the portion of the Project which lies directly under the I-35 elevated mainlanes from the face of curb of the outside lane of the northbound frontage road to the face of curb of the outside lane of the southbound frontage road. Upon completion of such work, the State will invoice the Local Government for the not to be exceeded cost of \$63,211.13 and the Local Government will pay the State such amount within 30 days of the receipt of an invoice for such work.

All other provisions of the original contract are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.

Article 2. Signatory Warranty

The signatories to this amendment warrant that each has the authority to enter into this agreement on behalf of the organization they represent.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, THE STATE AND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT have executed duplicate counterparts to effectuate this agreement.
