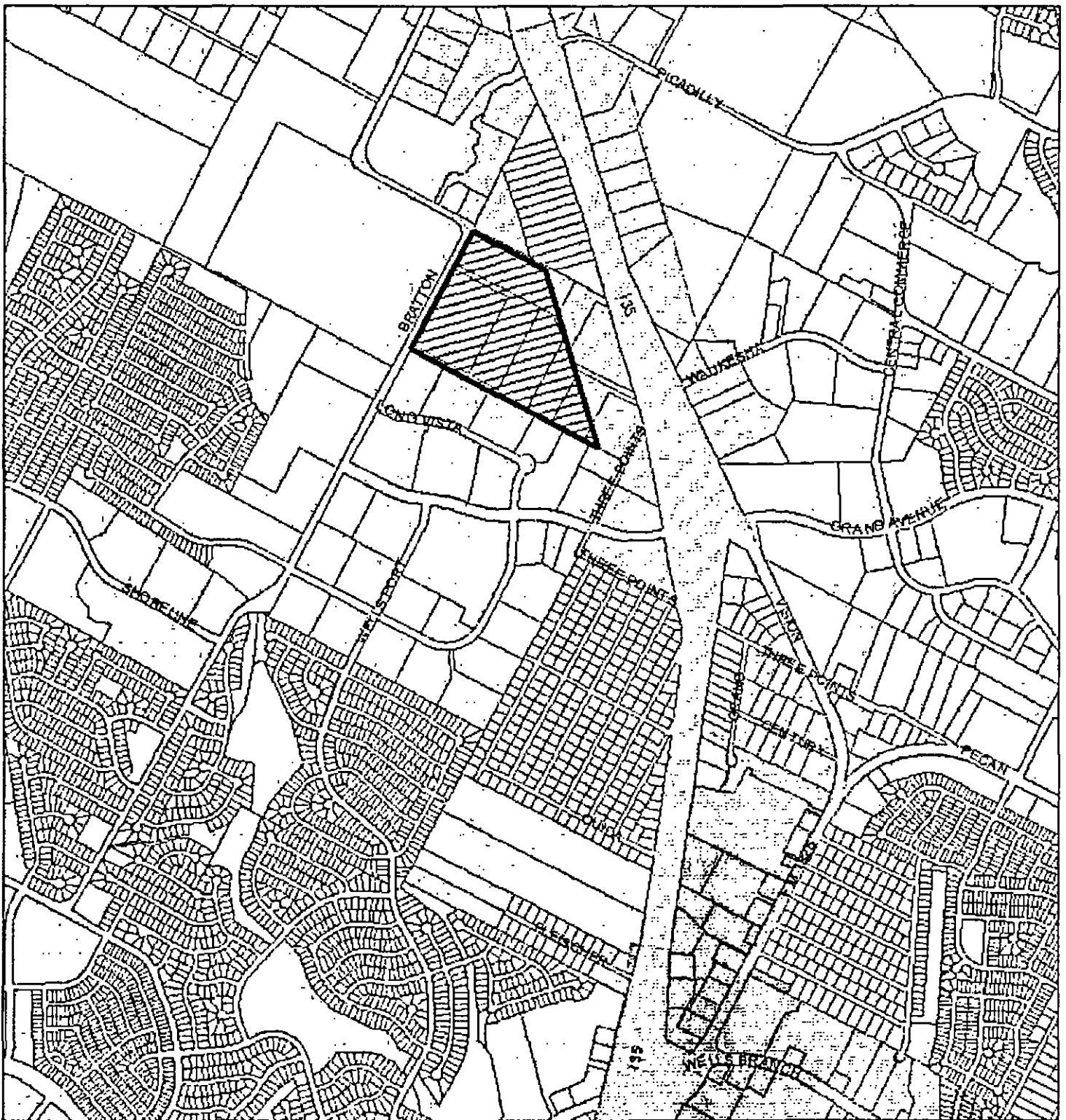


BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: N/A

The Scarbrough Subdivision area (approximately 46 acres) is located in Travis County west of the intersection of IH 35 North and Three Points Drive between Bratton Lane and IH 35 North. It is the site of an approved subdivision (C8-00-2052 0A) that is partially in the city's limited purpose jurisdiction and partially in the city's ETJ. The Scarbrough Subdivision area is being proposed for consensual limited purpose annexation and future conversion to full purpose annexation in accordance with the developer's request for annexation.
