

ORDINANCE NO. 050310-06

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 040913-01 TO APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$171,596 in carry-forward grant funds from the United States Department of State Health and Human Services, Office of the Secretary, Office of Public Health and Science, Office of Minority Health Technical Assistance and Capacity Development Demonstration Grant Program for HIV/AIDS-Related Services in Minority Communities.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Health and Human Services Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 040913-01 to appropriate \$171,596 to build the capacity of small and start-up community-based organizations to increase HIV-AIDS services and decrease AIDS infection in communities of color.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.




