# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-41 TO EXTEND THE CONGRESS AVENUE 35 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT; AND AMENDING SECTION 12-4-24 TO ADD OAK BOULEVARD, OAK BOULEVARD (EAST), OAK BOULEVARD (NORTH), OAK BOULEVARD (WEST) AND OAK BOULEVARD (SOUTH) TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR. 

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-41 (Maximum Speed Limit of 35 Miles Per Hour) of the City Code is amended as follows:

Congress Avenue (South) from 126.2 [681] feet south of Cesar Chavez Street $[$ Station $1+26)]$ to 354 feet south of center line of Oltorf Street (Station $142+$ 43).

PART 2. Section 12-4-24 (Maximum Speed Limit of 25 Miles per Hour) of the City Code is amended to add:

Oak Boulevard from U.S. Highway 290 (West) to Oak Boulevard (South);
Oak Boulevard (East) from Oak Boulevard (South) to Oak Boulevard (North);
Oak Boulevard (West) from Oak Boulevard (North) to Oak Boulevard (South);
Oak Boulevard (North) from Oak Boulevard (East) to Oak Boulevard (West); and
Oak Boulevard (South) from Oak Boulevard (West) to Oak Boulevard (East).
PART 3. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on March 22, 2004.
