AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE SIGNATURE REQUIREMENT IN CHAPTER 14-8 OF THE CODE, CERTAIN FEES AND CHARGES, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF CERTAIN COSTS FOR THE GREATER EAST AUSTIN YOUTH ASSOCIATION JUNETEENTH PARADE AND FESTIVAL TO BE HELD ON JUNE 19, 2004.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
