

**ORDINANCE NO. 040513-17**

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE SIGNATURE REQUIREMENT IN CHAPTER 14-8 OF THE CODE, CERTAIN FEES AND CHARGES, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF CERTAIN COSTS FOR THE GREATER EAST AUSTIN YOUTH ASSOCIATION JUNETEENTH PARADE AND FESTIVAL TO BE HELD ON JUNE 19, 2004.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** The Council waives the following fees and charges in connection with the Greater East Austin Youth Association Juneteenth Parade and Festival to be held on June 19, 2004:

Application Fee	\$ 100.00
Permit Fee	\$1,500.00
Security Deposit	\$ 50.00
Sign Permit Fee	(2 @ \$80.00) \$ 160.00
Banner Permit Review Fee	\$ 20.00
Sound Amplification Fee (PARD)	\$ 30.00
Park Maintenance Fee	\$ 300.00
Additional Events Park Maintenance Fee	\$1.00 per ticket
Special Events Deposit	\$2,000.00

**PART 2.** The Council authorizes reimbursement of the parade permit application fee in the amount of \$100 in connection with the Greater East Austin Youth Association Juneteenth Parade and Festival to be held on June 19, 2004.

**PART 3.** The Council authorizes payment of the following expenses in connection with the Greater East Austin Youth Association Juneteenth Parade and Festival:

Cleanup of parade route – Solid Waste Services Department	\$ 500.00
Police officers – Austin Police Department	\$5,106.15

Police officers – Parks & Recreation Department	\$3,728.00
Bike medic team and ambulance – Emergency Medical Services	\$1,600.00
Barricades – Transportation Services Department	\$2,800.00
Doris Miller Auditorium - Parks & Recreation Department	\$1,010.00
Park Rental Fee – Parks & Recreation Department	\$3,000.00
Portable Toilets – Parks & Recreation Department	\$ 168.00
Setup and cleanup – Parks & Recreation Department	\$1,000.00

**PART 4.** The Council waives the signature requirement in Code Section 14-8-16 (*Notice of Proposed Closure and Signature Requirement*) in connection with the Greater East Austin Youth Association Juneteenth Parade and Festival.
