## **ORDINANCE NO.** <u>040610-04</u>

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY; AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 AUSTIN WATER UTILITY DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 030909-01 TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

**PART 1.** The Council authorizing application for acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$2,073,200 from the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

**PART 2.** The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Austin Water Utility Department Operating Budget of Ordinance No. 030909-01 to appropriate \$2,073,200 for activities associated with the mitigation of sanitary sewer overflows.

**PART 3.** The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
