ORDINANCE NO. 040826-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 COMMUNITY CARE SERVICES DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 030909-01 TO APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS TO CREATE FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- **PART 1.** The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$987,833 in grant funds from the United States Health Resources and Services Administration, Bureau of Primary Health Care Expanded Medical Capacity grant program.
- **PART 2.** The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Community Care Services Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 030909-01 to appropriate \$987,833 in grant funds to create 19 full-time equivalent positions to increase the system capacity and medical encounters.
- **PART 3.** The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
