ORDINANCE NO. <u>040729-26</u>

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 MANAGEMENT SERVICES OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 030909-01 TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$756,597 in grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security Domestic Preparedness Grant to enhance local first response capabilities for terrorist incidents.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2003-2004 Management Services Operating Budget of Ordinance No. 030909-01 to appropriate \$756,597 to the Office of Emergency Management Special Revenue Fund.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
