

ORDINANCE NO. 041104-04

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 ELECTRIC UTILITY DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 040913-01 TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$17,500 in grant funds from the United States Department of Energy through the Texas State Energy Conservation Office.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Electric Utility Department Operating Budget of Ordinance No. 040913-01 as follows:

- (1) Appropriate \$17,500 for the purpose of continuing the City's involvement in the Clean Cities Program through August 31, 2005, for a total grant amount of \$82,500; and
- (2) Appropriate Program Income donated by Clean Cities participants in the amount of \$20,000 for administration of the Central Texas Clean Cities Program.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
