

ORDINANCE NO. 041104-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 040913-01 TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS AND ADD FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the acceptance of \$400,000 in grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security, Metro Medical Response System Program.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Office of Emergency Management Operating Budget of Ordinance No. 040913-01 to appropriate \$400,000 to the Management Services Special Revenue Fund for the enhancement of local medical and health care capabilities for terrorist incidents and to add two full-time equivalent positions.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.


