

A special session to the City Council is hereby called to meet in Council chamber, Smith Office Building, West Sixth Street, this Friday, January 3rd 1908, at 8:00 p.m. for the following purposes, viz:

1. To receive and act on the report of the City Hall Committee, in regard to furnishing new city hall with platforms, railings, etc.
2. To receive and act on the report of the Street Committee, in regard to cutting dam and removing the dirt, or gravel, from Colorado and Eighth streets and alley north of Eighth Street.
3. To consider a resolution requesting the Water and Light Commission to annually set aside the net earnings of Water, Light, and Power plant for the purpose of rebuilding the dam and power house.
3. To further consider an ordinance entitled "An ordinance granting and to the Consolidated Construction Co. in New Jersey a franchise to rebuild the dam across the Colorado River, at or near the site of the dam formerly erected across said River by the City of Austin.
