

Austin City Council MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING THURSDAY, AUGUST 2, 2001

The following represents the actions taken by the Austin City Council in the order they occurred during the meeting. While the minutes are not in sequential order, all agenda items were discussed.

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a regular meeting on Thursday, August 2, 2001 in the Board Room at Lower Colorado River Authority Hancock Building, 3700 Lake Austin Boulevard.

Mayor Watson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

1. Conduct a public hearing regarding proposed rate increase by TXU Gas Distribution Company.

The public hearing was closed on Council Member Griffith's motion, Mayor Pro Tem Goodman's second by a 5-0 vote. Council Member Wynn was off the dais.
