

Austin City Council MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MONDAY, AUGUST 6, 2001

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a regular meeting on August 6, 2001 at the South Rural Health Center, 3518 FM 973 South, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Watson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

1. Conduct a Public Hearing on the full purpose annexation of the Del Valle area (approximately, 1120 acres extending on the east side of U.S. 183, from the existing full purpose city limits near Hergotz Lane southeastwards along U.S. 183 and north of SH 71, to the existing full purpose city limits at Falwell Lane.

The presentation was made by Ben Luckens, Planning, Transportation and Sustainabilty; Commander Brad Conner, Austin Police Department; Pieter Sybersma, Austin Fire Department; Richard Harrington, Director, Emergency Medical Services; Mike Boyle, Water and Wastewater; Ed Poppitt, Street and Bridge; Alan Hughes, Public Works and Transportation; Jose Guerrera, Watershed Protection; Gregory Bolds, Health and Human Services; and Ann Hargrove, Solid Waste Services.
