

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING THURSDAY, AUGUST 9, 2001

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a Special Called Meeting on Thursday, August 9, 2001 in the Board Room at Lower Colorado River Authority Hancock Building, 3700 Lake Austin Boulevard.
